The Work Health Safety Inspection conducted by the MTA is a practical and hands on approach to WHS in your workshop.

The WHS Code of Practice for how to manage risks, recommends internal inspections be completed every 3 months. The WHS Inspection provides a structure that you can use moving forward to conduct regular internal inspections.

In addition, the WHS Inspection has been successfully utilised by both members and non-members to ensure they are compliant and prepared ahead of their RAA accreditation and/or re-accreditation inspection.

Undertaken by a member of the Industrial Relations team, the WHS inspection takes a comprehensive checklist approach, covering:

- Plant maintenance (incl. hoists and extinguishers)
- First aid
- Building and traffic management
- Staff training
- Risk assessments
- Emergency Evacuation procedures

At the end of the inspection your business will receive a compliance report with corrective actions which can be used as an action plan to address any non-compliance issues. You will also have gained an understanding of how to conduct regular inspections for yourself.
